### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Α. Read animal science division regulations and requirements for all animals, including Judging Contest, Herdsmanship, Fitting and Showing.
- Β. All Cavies must be tagged in the left ear for identification purposes.
- More than one entry of the same breed, color, age and sex is permitted. C.
- D. Exhibits may be limited as space is filled. All care will be taken to assure all members at least one exhibit in the division.
- All exhibitors will work on herdsmanship duty or premiums will be withheld. Ε.
- F. IF YOU ARE NOT BRINGING CAVIES YOU PRE-ENTERED. PLEASE REPORT THIS TO THE SUPERINTENDENT SO THAT SPACE CAN BE FILLED.
- G. Make out your entry forms carefully - cavies will be judged as entered.
- Breeders class: Cavies entered in these classes must have been born and raised by the exhibitor during the current 4-H year. H.
- Cavies may be rejected because of insects or disease. I.
- All exhibitors must enter Fitting & Showing with an animal also entered in Type. .1
- Schedule of events may be adjusted to accommodate the safety of the animals if weather is hot. K.
- Parental help is appreciated in setting up and tearing down. L.
- M. Limit 10 cavies per exhibitor
- Exhibitor MUST provide suitable cavy exhibition cage with a safe solid bottom. N.
- О. Cavy must be a minimum of 12 ounces to show at fair.
- Weights and Standards as specified by the American Rabbit Breeders Association Standards of Perfection will be considered as basis for P. judging.
