REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Must be enrolled in Clothing & Textile project.

- D. Intermediates (show two skills listed) and Seniors construct garment(s) including three skills listed in "Pattern Requirements" available at Extension Office & Billie's Designer Fabrics.
- E. Prepare sample garment, care instruction card, poster sketch or picture of garment and verbal explanation of timesaving techniques, and advantage of your fiber selection.
- F. Table, chair, iron and ironing board will be provided, bring everything else needed.
- G. Cut out and mark garment(s) before activity.
- H. Complete contest worksheet.
- I. Within contest hours, construct garment(s), model for judge, and clean the area.
- J. Make garment available for display for remainder of the fair.
