#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Read 4-H Animal ScienceDepartment regulations and requirements for all animals, including judging contest, fitting and showing, herdsmanship A. and bowls. See Also Ribbon Awards.
- The exhibitor will be limited to not more than 10 entries for Lewis County Juniors, 15 entries for Lewis County Intermediates, 20 entries for Lewis В. County Seniors and 15 entries for Out of Lewis County 4-H'ers. Based on space available.
- С Birds shown in a trio or pen cannot be shown as a single.
- Poultry Superintendent will check all poultry for parasites, cleanliness and illness. Any birds deemed diseased, infested or dirty may be refused D. entry. At any time during the fair if a bird is found to be diseased or infested exhibitor will be asked to remove birds from the fairgrounds. All animals - should be ready for exhibition when they arrive at the fairgrounds.

- 4-H Fitting and Showing; Tuesday 1PM. Type to follow. All birds must be banded with an identifying number with this number also being recorded on the exhibitor's coop tag. This number is the bird's Α. identification to the owner.
- ENTRY FORM MUST SHOW MANNER IN WHICH EACH BIRD IS TO BE SHOWN, WHETHER AS A COCK, HEN, COCKEREL, OR PULLET. G ALSO BREED AND VARIETY AND STANDARD OR BANTAM.
- For the purpose of this exhibition, the terms "Cock" and "Hen" shall mean birds over one year of age. The terms "Cockerel" and "Pullet" shall H. mean birds less than one year of age.
- All 4-H exhibits will be under care of 4-H Poultry Superintendent and 4-H'ers on herdsmanship. (There will be no charge for feed or care of the I.
- birds.) Individuals must clean pens and check on their birds daily. All exhibitors--in county and out of county--must sign up for herdsmanship and participate or no premiums will be awarded to exhibitor J for the entire department. When on herdsmanship, youth should wear a long sleeved shirt and close toed shoes appropriate for the barn.
- Exhibitor must participate in fitting and showing or no premiums will be awarded for the entire department. Exhibitors should wear long-sleeved, K. button-down shirts during fitting and showing. This is standard 4-H attire.
- See 4-H Market Sale Division 17 for all market animals, must be Cornish X (cross), single turkey, ducks, or goose.
- ALL POULTRY IS TO BE VET CHECKED AND COOPED IN BY MONDAY 3 PM to 8 PM. Coop in includes stall cards and all paperwork Μ. completed.
- N. All birds must have any state mandated blood tests prior to fair. Proper paperwork must come with bird (receipts or certificates). О.
