- * Applicant must be entering or attending a school of post secondary education. (includes trade school) Monies may be used for tools or supplies. Must be enrolled within one year of receiving this scholarship.
- *The Applicant will be required to submit a letter of recommendation from a 4-H leader/FFA advisor, coach, teacher, or member of the livestock industry. (The letter may not be from a family member.)
- *Letters of recommendation may arrive with the application or separately by mail, If mailed separately, postmark deadlines still apply.
- *Applications will be judged on participation and involvement with sports, livestock, leadership and community service.
- * Applications will be available at the Lewis Co Extension Office, SWWJLS website, and WF West and Centralia High School Counseling Centers.
- *Applications must be postmarked by May 1st, 2022 and mailed to Joe Parypa Scholarship Committee, *c/o SWW* Jr Livestock Committee, PO Box 1635, Chehalis, WA 98532
- *The recipient(s) will be notified by June 15 and the scholarship will be awarded at the SWW Jr Livestock Sale. The recipients' presence is expected, but not required.
- *The decision of the Joe Parypa Scholarship Committee is final,
- *The Joe Parypa Scholarship Committee has the right to change or amend the scholarship application annually.
- *Recipients must submit a College transcript after their first quarter/semester of school and then Scholarship Committee will mail a check to the school at the address provided by the recipient.
